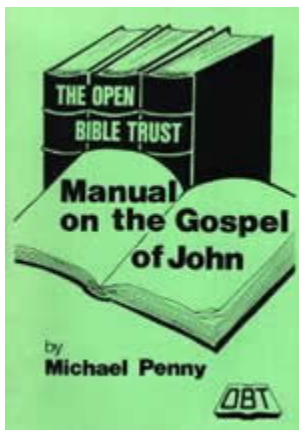
It is suggested that you read a chapter of John's Gospel and then try to answer the questions on that chapter. This can be done either in private study or in group discussions. If you have any difficulty in answering, aids and hints are giving in parentheses after the question. These direct you to verses which will help you answer.

In working through John's Gospel we have attempted to do three things:

- 1) Show clearly who Jesus Christ is;
- 2) Show clearly that faith in Him secures forgiveness of sins and eternal life;
- 3) Help the believer grow in faith, love and knowledge.

265. Did the disciples know it was the Lord Jesus? (v 12)
266. How many times had the Lord Jesus appeared to His disciples after His death? (v 14)
267. What three questions did the Lord Jesus ask Peter? (vs 15,16,17)
268. What four instructions did He give Peter? (vs 15,16,17,19)
269. The Lord Jesus indicated what death Peter would suffer but did this deter Peter from following Him? (vs 18,19)
270. How do we know that the disciple often alluded to, but never mentioned, is John, the writer of this gospel? (vs 20-24)
271. Did the Lord Jesus do many other things? (v 25 and also John 20:30)

Answers to these questions are given in
The Manual on the Gospel of John
by Michael Penny.

Having completed our study, it would be a good idea to read right through John's Gospel again. This will be of great help and the reader will be surprised how much is recalled and how much has been learnt.
